




# **INSTALLATION:**


- Read all installation instructions before beginning the installation of the Parex USA 360 Fast Window Mesh.
- Surface must be clean, dry, frostfree and suitable for application of a Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs coatings.
- Pre-measure the Parex USA 360 Fast Window Mesh depth to match the depth of the rough opening and trim to fit, if needed (Fig 1).




- Apply Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs to the thickness per the current product datasheet into the corner 4" onto the face of the sheathing (Fig 2).
- Embed the Parex USA 360 Fast Window Mesh into the wet coating (Fig 3).
- Repeat for all 4 corners (Fig 4).












- Before applying the Parex USA Weather Tech WRB to other areas, pre-cut and fold the 6" or 9" Parex USA 396 Sheathing Tape to fit in between each corner piece and overlap approximately 2" onto the corner pieces (Fig 5).
- Apply the Parex USA WeatherTech WRB to the rest of the rough opening (Fig 6).







- Embed Folded Sheathing Tape into the wet Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs (Fig 7).
- Immediately place the Parex USA 396 Sheathing Tape centered in the wet Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs (Fig 8).


Run a trowel or taping knife over the sheathing joint tape to embed it into the wet Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs.


Do not let Parex USA WeatherSeal Spray & Roll-On or Parex USA WeatherBlock SP1 Spray & Roll-On skin over before applying and embedding Parex USA 396 Sheathing Tape.

Work in small enough areas to ensure that Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs is wet when Parex USA 396 Sheathing Tape is embedded in it. Ensure the rough openings are completely covered with mesh.

If Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs does skin over before embedding Parex USA 396 Sheathing Tape, scrape off semiliquid Parex USA Weather Tech WRBs or let it dry, and in both cases, re-apply appropriate amount.
